

FHC Door Rails and Patch Fittings Cleaning and Preventative Maintenance Tips

CLEANING

Routine regular maintenance prevents dirt and grime deposits from building up on FHC Door Rail's and Patch Fitting's surface metals. If left neglected, chemicals in the air will discolor and tarnish any decorative metal finish.

To promote the aesthetic longevity of FHC Door Rails and Patch Fittings, a regimented cleaning program should be put in place. Simply wipe the surfaces down on a weekly basis using a mild liquid soap and warm water, and a rinse with clean fresh water. Dry all surfaces completely with a clean, dry microfiber cloth or chamois. **DO NOT** let water dry by air, as this will cause water spotting on the metal's surface.



WARNING: Do not use any type of abrasive cleaners or abrasive clothes on FHC Door Rails or Patch Fittings. Always wear eye protection and rubber gloves when using cleaning soaps and detergents.

PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE

Refer to FHC's installation instructions for product specific details.

- Visual inspection is recommended biannually on all moving parts to ensure they are free from dirt and debris.
- All fasteners should be checked for tightness (recommended torque setting 15Nm).
- Heavy traffic entrances should be visually inspected and maintained monthly.
